  - b. Describe any experiences, talent, and skills you can contribute to the Camas School District.
  - c. Give a brief biographical sketch of self: training, interests, experience on policy boards, community and/or school activities, etc.
  - d. In your opinion, what are the most significant challenges facing public schools today? How would you propose to address these challenges?
  - e. What does equity mean to you?
2. Identify any commitments that might prevent you from attending regularly scheduled workshops and meetings (4:30 PM every second Monday of the month and 5:30 PM every fourth Monday of the month), reviewing study materials, etc.
3. Attach a resume and at least three community references.
