What: Portland Business District Cleanup, sponsored by The Standard

When: September 18, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am

Event Description: Portland's business districts are the heartbeat of our city and keeping them clean is vital to our economy and the environment. Together with The Standard, SOLVE volunteers will tackle litter in Downtown Portland. In honor of Hispanic Heritage Month and Cesar Chavez, who led the first successful farm workers union in American history, after the cleanup SOLVE will accept non-perishable food to be donated to Hacienda CDC, a Latino-led Community Development Corporation located in NE Portland.

Why: Litter poses a significant threat to our community's well-being, affecting the aesthetics and overall health of our streets, neighborhoods, and waterways. SOLVE's creates opportunities for individuals and businesses to give back to their communities and play a critical role in preserving the beauty and integrity of our city from the harmful effects of trash. Together, we can create a cleaner, more inviting downtown that reflects our pride in the city and care for our community.

Media Crews: Arrive by 8:45 outside the main entrance of The Standard to see approximately 130 volunteers of all ages checking in, collecting their cleanup supplies, receiving a safety speech, event debrief, and then heading out in groups to pick up litter in the surrounding area. The event will run from 9 am to 11 am, with volunteers expected to spread throughout Downtown.

This event will have plenty of visuals of volunteers picking up litter, making for great community packages, VOs, and VOSOTS.
